8:45 – 9:05 GREETING TIME – Welcome children into the nursery to start their day. Take part in wake up shake up sessions.

9:05 – 9:15 WELCOME & PLANNING TIME – This is part of the daily routine when children and staff meet at their group area to do the register, sing our welcome song, count our friends (0-10 song, days of the week and talk about the weather). The children then make choices and decisions about where they would like to work in the nursery and how they are going to do this. These ideas/plans are encouraged and supported by key workers.

9:15 – 10:25 WORK TIME – The children are encouraged to do whatever activities they have planned and at this time are free to work in all areas of the nursery, exploring materials, learning new skills and trying out their ideas. This is all achieved through well-planned play.

10:00 – 10:30 Nappies are changed, children who out of nappies are encouraged to use the toilet at this time.

10:25 – 10:35 TIDY UP TIME – The children tidy away materials they have been working with. This is a valuable learning experience for children as it develops their self-help skills and a sense of responsibility for their environment as well as encouraging them to co-operate with and help others.

10:35 – 10:40 WASHING HANDS – The children are independently encouraged to wash their hands and sit down at the snack table.

10:40 – 10:55 SNACK AND RECALL TIME – During snack time, the children are encouraged to talk about what they have been doing their work time. This helps to develop children's communication and language and literacy skills.

10:55 – 11:30 OUTSIDE PLAY – This is a time when all the children go outside and explore and investigate the outdoor learning environment, developing their skills of knowledge and understanding of the world. It also helps to develop the children's physical skills. During outside play time a small group of children will be taken inside for 10-minute targeted interventions.

11:30 – 11:35 SINGING TIME – This is time for the children to come together and join in with simple songs and nursery rhymes.
