#### Chorley Schools Sports Partnership (CSSP) Y5/6 Culture Competition

Our Y5 and Y6 were visited by staff from the CSSP today to encourage the children to take part in an exciting competition about innovation in sport. They explored how innovation in sport has been so important in allowing athletes with disabilities to enjoy and compete in a variety of sporting competitions for example at the Paralympics. Mr Cahalin reported that the children listened and took part well and that they were excited to take up the challenge.

#### Tax-free childcare

One of our governors shared some information with me last year to pass on to parents and carers - here is a reminder, in case your circumstances have changed.:

You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year). For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay in £2 to use to pay your provider.

You can get Tax-Free Childcare at the same time as 30 hours free childcare if you're eligible for both. You can use Tax-Free Childcare for: childminders, nurseries and nannies and after school clubs and play schemes. <a href="https://www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare">https://www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare</a>
