

SEVEN MORE VERSES OF SCRIPTURE ALL CATHOLICS SHOULD KNOW -

 For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead.
- 3. Romans 8:13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

SEVEN HOLY FOUNDERS OF
THE SERVITE ORDER: Memorial
on Monday 17th February. These
were devout 13th century people
from Florence, who included some
of the most well-known and
affluent families of the city. The
seven founders, Bonfilius,
Bonajuncta, Amadeus, Hugh,
Manettus, Sostene, and Alexis,
were jointly canonized in 1888, In

response to the Cathar heresy, they founded a Confraternity of the Blessed Virgin Mary and later an Order of Friars called Servites or Servants of Mary. The led a life of prayer and austerity on nearby Mount Sennario, where they built a church and hermitage. In 1240, they adopted a stable way of life based on the rule of St. Augustine, wearing a black habit. Their signature devotion is to the Seven Sorrows of Mary. They set up further foundations in nearby towns and cities, most famously the Annunziata church in Florence, which they still serve. The Servite Order was solemnly approved by Pope Benedict XI in 1259 and has since spread to many parts of the world. Houses in the Uk are in London Fulham Road, Kersal Salford, and Benburb, Dungannon, Co Tyrone.
