#### <u>PRIMARY</u>

Nursery/ pre-school children – due to start Reception class in primary school in September 2020. The statutory **closing date is 15 January 2020.**

**VERY IMPORTANT: You must apply even if you already have siblings in school**. If you live in Lancashire you can include out of area preferences on your online application.

\*\*Please remember that admissions to St Mary's, or any Catholic primary schools, also require the completion of <u>the separate supplementary information form (SIF).\*\*</u>

#### Break time snacks

Children (and staff) do get a bit peckish around about break time and we are happy for them to have a snack. Our policy is for this snack to be toast or a piece of fruit on Monday to Thursday and a snack of their choice on a Friday. The school provides toast which works out at 20p a day on a pre-ordered basis. Alternatively, children may bring in a snack from home. We do ask that all pupils adhere to this rule. <u>Chocolate bars, sweets and crisps are not allowed on Monday to Thursday.</u>

You can see how the winter bugs have hit attendance this week. We have had nearly 30-40 children off most days this week (25 today). Ordinarily, it is always under 5 absences a day.

#### Health and Safety Reminder – sickness and/ or diarrhoea

This is the time of year when there are more bugs and germs around than usual. If your child does become ill with **sickness or diarrhoea**, the guidance for schools from Public Health England gives a minimum recommended absence from school of 48 **hours**. This is to limit the spread of the bug around school. Thank you.


