Dear Parents/ Carers

Revised advice from Lancashire County Council regarding wider re-opening of St Mary's School & Nursery

Today, Dr Sakthi Karunanithi, Director of Public Health at Lancashire County Council, advised Lancashire schools to delay reopening to Nursery, Reception, Year 1, and Year 6 pupils because, in his professional view, two of the government's five coronavirus tests are not currently being met in the county. This advice will be reviewed again next Monday 15 June, and if it changes, he will encourage us to take the decision to reopen to more pupils from **Monday 22 June** if deemed safe to do so.

We have planned carefully for the safe return of children in Nursery, Reception and Year 1 alongside critical workers' and vulnerable children who are accessing childcare. In future newsletters, I will remind of you of the measures we have put in place and of any changes that we will need to make to them. The Governing Body will be meeting again next week and they will once again discuss the plans and advice regarding reopening.
