Hear, Believe, Celebrate, Live

John the Baptist is a prophet who calls people back to God by encouraging them to say sorry and ask for forgiveness; Baptism is a sign of forgiveness.

"Turn away from your sins and be baptised, and God will forgive your sins." Get the road ready for the Lord; make a straight path for him to travel! "The whole human race will see God's salvation!" So John said to all of them, "I baptise you with water, but someone is coming who is much greater than I am. I am not good enough even to untie his sandals. He will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire." (Luke 3:2-6, 10-17). Water is used as a symbol of a new start in the Sacrament of Baptism.





When people make bad choices (sin), they turn away from God. Jesus teaches us that God loves and forgives and that being sorry helps us to change and become better people.

The **Trinity** means that God is three persons in one:

God the Father, God the Son (Jesus), and God the Holy Spirit.

When we pray to God, we can say that we are sorry and ask for forgiveness, using the Our Father and the Act of Contrition.




O my God, because you are so good, I am very sorry that I have sinned against you and with the help of your grace, I will not sin again.



Our Father,

Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation. but deliver us from evil





Is it easier to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you', or to say, 'Get up and walk'? I will prove to you, then, that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins," So he said to the paralysed man, "I tell you, get up, pick up your bed and go home!" At once, the man got up in front of them all, took the bed he had been lying on, and went home, praising God. (Luke 5:17–26)





The disciples went to Jesus and woke him up, saying, "Master, Master! We are about to die!" Jesus got up and gave an order to the wind and the stormy water; they died down, and there was a great calm. Then he said to the disciples, "Where is your faith?" (Luke 8:22-25) - Jesus brings
