The elements of *Learning, Reading, Speaking and Writing* are covered and developed in each year group.

- > Phonics and Sound Spellings are ongoing throughout the French programme.
- > Core language is repeated in year groups with grammatical aspects (articles, nouns, adjectives, verbs, conjunctions) explored and built upon in every year of language learning.
- > Use of questions and answers and role plays are commonly used in lessons and the focus is introduced and revisited with native clips, including more challenging activities.
- > Independent creative use of language in speaking and writing are offered methodically.
- > Seasonal celebrations and cultural festivals form an integral part of French activities at different times of the year, including cross curricular activities linking with the wider areas of the curriculum.
