The elements of ***Learning, Reading, Speaking and Writing*** are covered and developed in each year group.

- ***Phonics and Sound Spellings*** are ongoing throughout the French programme.
- ***Core language*** is repeated in year groups with grammatical aspects (articles, nouns, adjectives, verbs, conjunctions) explored and built upon in every year of language learning.
- ***Use of questions and answers and role plays*** are commonly used in lessons and the focus is introduced and revisited with native clips, including more challenging activities.
- ***Independent creative use of language*** in speaking and writing are offered methodically.
- ***Seasonal celebrations and cultural festivals*** form an integral part of French activities at different times of the year, including cross curricular activities linking with the wider areas of the curriculum.
