

## St Mary's Catholic Primary and Nursery Languages: French

## Overview of Learning 2020-2021



## In studying the language of French, children will be learning to:

- ✓ listen attentively to spoken French and show understanding by joining in and responding
- ✓ explore the patterns and sounds of the French language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words
- ✓ engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others
- ✓ speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures
- ✓ develop accurate pronunciation and intonation so that others understand when they are reading aloud or using familiar words and phrases
- ✓ present ideas and information orally to a range of audiences
- ✓ read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing
- ✓ appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language
- ✓ broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words that are introduced into familiar written material,
- ✓ write phrases from memory, and adapt these to create new sentences, to express ideas clearly
- ✓ describe people, places, things and actions orally and in writing
- ✓ understand basic French grammar, including feminine, masculine nouns and the conjugation of high-frequency verbs; key features and patterns of the language; how to apply these, for instance, to build sentences; and how these differ from or are similar to English.

In addition, through learning the language of French, they will also be learning about aspects of France, its geography, its history, its culture and the French people.

The elements of learning, described above, are addressed and developed in each year group. The learning is delivered through the topics as in the table below:
