If teacher is unwell with symptoms, COVID positive or negative, school will make arrangements to cover class and provide teaching and learning as is usual when teachers are off ill.

Broadcast pre-recorded videos sent home as long as whole class permissions are in place. Permissions needed for all pupils for this. Office will make arrangements for this.
