

## **SWIMMING ATTAINMENT FOR YEAR 6 COHORT 2023/ 2024**

The children at St Mary's attend swimming lessons when they are in Year 4. The figures below show what they were able to do at the end of the course of lessons & swimming boosters.

<b>Meeting national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety.</b>	<b>%</b>
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres? N.B. Even though your pupils may swim in another year please report on their attainment on leaving primary school at the end of the summer term 2020.	83 %
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]?	50 %
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?	100 %
