Welcome back! We can't believe we are already half way through the school year! We've got another busy and fun filled half term to look forward to!

Topic

Our topic in Nursery for this half term is 'Where do the wheels on the bus go?' This topic is based around vehicles, journeys and transport! Please see the curriculum overview which outlines what your child will be learning over the next few weeks. I have included as much information as possible so that you have some idea of the activities your child might have been up to while at Nursery. Like last half term, we'd like to see what the children would like to learn about as much as possible, so we will send home a blank 'planning map' for you to include your child's interests and what they may wish to learn about. From this, I will then include these ideas in my planning so that your child receives a bespoke curriculum involving home, school and your child in the planning process. We will be reading a story called 'The Naughty Bus' and our travelling bear will be visiting London.

Our RED topic this term is Branch 4 - Desert to Garden. This will lead us up to Easter learning about Lent and how Jesus died on the cross and was given new life by God his father.

Key vocabulary: Lent, Commandment, Neighbour, Rose/Risen, Jesus, God

Outdoor Provision

We all have daily access to outdoor play. Outdoor learning is an essential part of children's development so please could I ask that each child brings a coat and waterproof shoes to Nursery every day as it can get be messy and wet! This means we can enjoy playing outside whatever the weather! Please ensure that your child's wellies and coat are clearly labelled. A change of spare clothes is also really helpful and can also be left in Nursery.
