Welcome back! We hope you have all had a refreshing half term break. We can't believe it is our last few weeks together before some children transition into Reception class.. We have had a great year in Nursery. We have learnt many new things and had many exciting times! The Nursery Team would like to take this opportunity to say thank you

Topic

Our topic in Nursery for this half term is 'Transport, Journeys and Water' a topic based around the sea, the seaside and the journeys we make to get there! Please see my previous attachment on class story containing the curriculum overview, which outlines what your child will be learning over the next few weeks. I have included as much information as possible so that you have some idea of the activities your child might be up to while at Nursery. Like last half term, we'd like to see what the children would like to learn about as much as possible, so we have sent home a blank 'planning map' for you to include your child's interests and what they may wish to learn about. From this, we will then include these ideas in our planning so that your child receives a bespoke curriculum involving home, school and your child in the planning process. Our literacy focussed text for the half term will be 'I'm the bus driver' and 'Oh look a boat'

We will start the half term continuing with our 'to the Ends of the Earth' topic. We will continue learning about our love for God and how to be like Jesus and learning to live like Jesus did. We will also have some visits to learn about other faiths over the next half term.



Outdoor Provision

We all have daily access to outdoor play. Outdoor learning is an essential part of children's development so please could we ask that each child brings whatever necessary to play outside - whatever the weather - a coat or jacket for if it gets cooler, wellies and waterproof all in ones.

Please ensure that your child's wellies and coat are clearly labelled. A change of spare clothes is also really helpful and can also be left in Nursery.



Also this term, please bring a sun hat and apply sun cream before nursery. We will reapply the sun cream you provide at lunchtime if needed (both clearly labelled please).



Nursery will have PE Thursday morning. Please can your child come to Nursery in trainers or shoes and clothes that they can easily run, climb and jump on those days.

- Please make sure that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled with their name.
- Your child has access to either milk or water and a piece of fruit throughout the day. They can visit the snack table when they wish to during continuous provision time. Please only send water for your child's drink, if you wish for them to have juice with their packed lunch, they can use our jug and cups for water through the day.
- We also offer toast each morning. If you would like your child to have toast, please arrange payment at the school office.
- Spare clothes - we have limited spare leggings/joggers/underwear and socks in Nursery! Please could we ask that spare clothes from nursery are returned, many thanks.
- Nursery trip - due to the increase in cost of coaches we have not been able to have our usual farm visit as it made the cost of the trip quite expensive. Instead I have arranged a farm visit to school. More details of this will come from the office soon.
- Nursery Graduation Ceremony for those children moving to Reception is on Thursday 26th June - More information to come with regards to tickets from the school office. If children are not in this day please book them in through the school office as soon as possible. Children will have a professional photograph and a full class photograph before the ceremony.
