Welcome back! We can't believe we are already half way through the school year! We've got another busy and fun filled half term to look forward to! Firstly I'd like to thank everyone for coming to the Parents evenings it was great to be able to have those meetings face -to-face and discuss some of the fantastic things your children have been doing and where we will be taking the learning next.

# **Topic**

Our topic in Nursery for this half term is 'Where do the wheels on the bus go?' This topic is based around vehicles, journeys and transport! Please see the curriculum overview which outlines what your child will be learning over the next few weeks. I have included as much information as possible so that



you have some idea of the activities your child might have been up to while at Nursery. Like last half term, we'd like to see what the children would like to learn about as much as possible, so we will send home a blank 'planning map' for you to include your child's interests and what they may wish to learn about. From this, I will then include these ideas in my planning so that your child receives a bespoke curriculum involving home, school and your child in the planning process. We will be reading a story called 'The Naughty Bus'. Please ask your children about what adventures the naughty bus gets up to!

# Come and See (RE)



We will be continuing with our 'Come and See' topic 'Gathering'. In this topic children will know and understand how and why people gather together and the joy of gathering together to celebrate at mass. Then we will look at the topic 'Growing'. This includes learning about Spring and also about Lent being a time for growing in love. We will learn about Good Friday and looking forward to Easter.

## **Outdoor Provision**

We all have daily access to outdoor play. Outdoor learning is an essential part of children's development so please could I ask that each child brings a coat and waterproof shoes to Nursery every day as it can get be messy and wet! This means we can enjoy playing outside whatever the weather! Please ensure that your child's wellies and coat are clearly labelled. A change of spare clothes is also really helpful and can also be left in Nursery.

We would like to say a BIG thank you for all the 'magic moment' sent into Nursery last half term. They are an excellent way for you to contribute to your child's learning journey and the children thoroughly enjoy sharing them with everyone in Nursery. ## Vocabulary



Here is a list of some fantastic words for your children to learn over this next half term. The words are linked to spring. Buds, chick, tadpoles, duckling, blossom, spring, hatch, grow, plant. Some extra words (step on words) that you may like to explore are frog spawn, offspring, decompose.

- Your child has access to either milk or water and a piece of fruit throughout the day. They can
  visit the snack table when they wish to during continuous provision time.
- We also offer toast each morning.
