Welcome to your weekly overview for week beginning **1st March 2021**. Our last week of home learning! We've made it and I'm sure the children are just as excited about returning to school as all the staff are. We have really missed being in the classroom and cannot wait to see everyone again.

Weekly Activities for Week beginning 01.03. 21

- * In the zoo and jungle there are lots of noises. Go for a walk with a grown up and then draw some of the things you can hear on your walk.
- * Draw a picture/collage of your favourite zoo animal - think about its pattern and colours
- * Make a snake - it could be a picture, a painting, a sock puppet or using up unwanted cardboard and containers
- * The animals all move in different ways. Move around like the different animals and see if the people at home can guess which animal you are pretending to be!
- * Choose 3 animals you would find in the zoo. Draw a picture showing them in size order, from the biggest to the smallest
- * Make a price label for your dinner in the evening. Ensure every member of your household has some coins before they sit down at the table. Make sure they all pay correctly for their meal before they sit down. How many different ways did you make that total using the coins?

Overview of learning to be covered

Here is a brief over view of what your child will be learning about in each area of learning. This is not for you to teach ahead as lots of my lessons are in a loom video for your child to follow. The learning for each day will be uploaded to Tapestry at 4.30pm the day before. This will allow time for you to read it through beforehand and ask any questions you may have about the next day's learning.
