Maths:

- Exploring the concepts of addition and subtraction.
- Exploring a range of different strategies to complete addition and subtraction calculations.
- Exploring missing number problems.
- Exploring the concept of multiplication and how to use arrays to solve calculations.
- Exploring the concept of division and how to share objects equally to complete calculations.
- Recalling times table facts and using these to solve calculations.
- Exploring length and height.
- Exploring statistics by creating tally charts, bar charts, pictograms and tables.

Year 1 and 2 Phonics:

- Consolidating the phonemes within phase 5.
- Introducing new idea that one phoneme can have many different graphemes.
- Continuing to introduce and consolidate tricky words.
- Beginning to introduce the idea of spelling rules and patterns.

Year 1 and 2 Music

- Exploring a variety of songs and performing these for each other.
- Exploring how to play a range of different un-tuned percussion and to be able to use these to accompany our singing.
- Exploring the musical element of pitch as high and low notes.
- Playing high and low notes together on the Glockenspiel.

Year 1 and 2 MFL

Year 1 and 2 English—Book Focus: The Journey Home:

- Predicting what will happen next in the story.
- Re-telling the story using story maps.
- Exploring adjectives to create a setting for their own stories.
- Re-writing the story to create their own version.
- Exploring past and present tenses and using these within their writing.
- Exploring a variety of punctuation and how to use this within their writing.
- Exploring speech marks and how these can be used within a story.

Year 1 and 2 Medium Term plan Spring 2 Nurturing Nurses

Year 1 and 2 History

- Exploring the lives of Florence Nightingale, Edith Cavell and Mary Seacole.
- Exploring the differences that these nurses have made to modern medicine today.
- Exploring how medicines have changed because of the contributions of each of these nurses.
- Exploring the chronological order of these nurses.

Year 1 and 2 PSHE

Drug, alcohol and tobacco education: What do we put into and on to bodies?

Pupils learn:

- about what can go into bodies and how it can make people feel
- about what can go on to bodies and how it can make people feel

Year 1 and 2 Science:

- Exploring seasonal changes within our school grounds.
- Exploring the four seasons and the weather that you would expect to have within each season.
- Exploring how the daylight hours change at different times of the year.
- Exploring how the earth orbits the sun and how this creates day and night.
- Exploring how to keep ourselves safe when it is sunny, for example wearing a sunhat and sun cream.
- Year 1 and 2 Religious Education 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?'
- Exploring the Easter story and why it is important to Christians.
- Exploring each day of Easter and what Christians do on each day.
- Exploring and Easter symbols and why these are important to Christians.
- Creating our own Easter arts and crafts.

Year 1 and 2 Computing

 Learners will explore using individual commands, both with other learners and as part of a computer program. They will identify what each floor robot command does and use that knowledge to start predicting the outcome of programs. The unit is paced to ensure time is spent on all aspects of programming and builds knowledge in a structured manner. Learners are also introduced to the early stages of program design through the introduction of algorithms.

Year 1 and 2 Art

- Studying the life and works of Vincent Van Gogh.
- Focus on creating Starry Starry Night and Irises.
- Texture, colour and movement in art.
