The Seven Areas:

Personal, social, and emotional development.

Literacy development/comprehension/word reading/writing

Mathematics - number and numerical patterns

Understanding the world. - Past and present - people, culture and communities, the natural world.

Expressive arts and design - Creating with materials

In Addition to this we teach daily phonics, guided reading and number discreetly.
