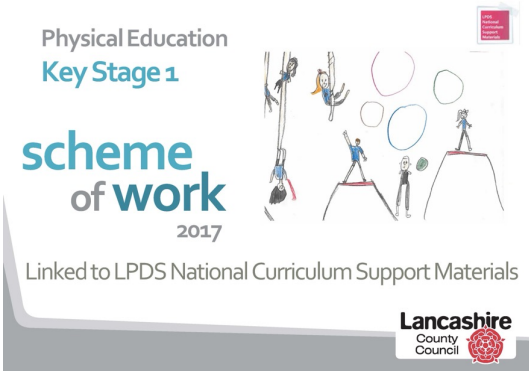

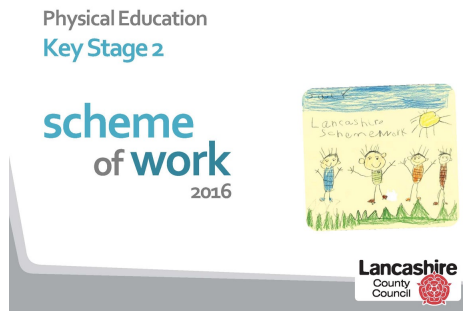
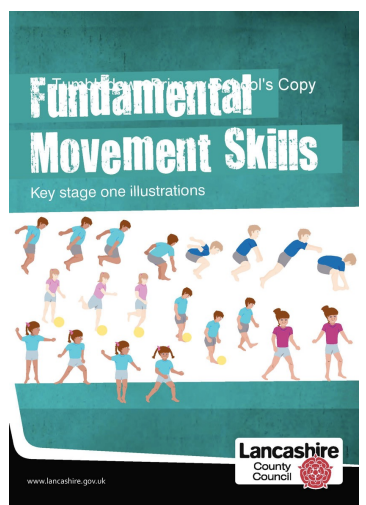

KS1 - FMS**

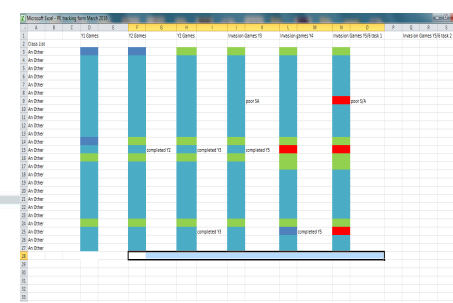


**KS1 FMS Baseline

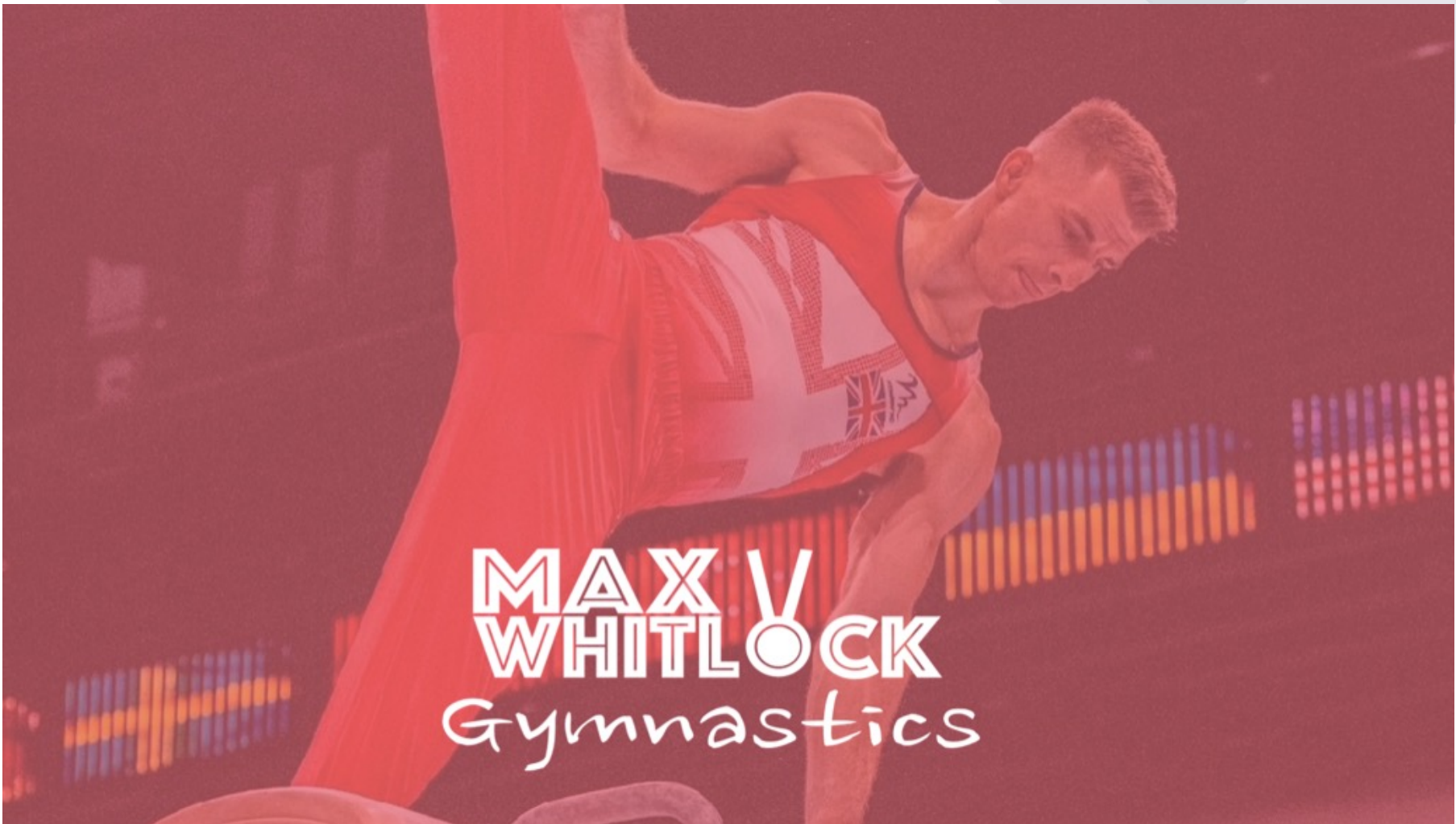

5 under 5 Assessment

- Children are assessed at either Stage 1,2 or 3
- This information is passed onto the Year 1 teacher before the baseline
- Pippa and Eddie for nursery and reception in PE and/or Continuous Provision



The Lancashire 5 FMS skills for under 5s are:

1. Running fast
2. Hopping
3. Jumping
4. Throws – roll, under and over
5. Catching



What is the Lancashire baseline?

- 10 key FMS skills chosen by Lancashire
- Build on Reception SOW
- Uses Stages of Development



Mastering Basic Movements

The Lancashire key FMS skills are:

1. Running fast
2. Hopping
3. Skipping
4. Jumping
5. Underarm throw
6. Overarm throw
7. Rolling a ball
8. Bouncing a ball
9. Kicking a ball
- 10 Catching



Curriculum Design and Coverage

- Lancashire PE Scheme of Work is designed to be developmental in both physical competence i.e. FMS leads to sport specific skills and also in how the children develop their cognitive or thinking skills i.e. how to apply their skills in a game or activity.
- Coverage of progressive skills and application of skills through Lancashire core tasks.

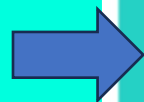





Assessment- Formative

Lesson

- Lesson objective
- Success criteria
- Link outcome – silver expected standard (majority), Gold – exceeding, Bronze – working towards
- Evidence – start and end of unit 1 silver, 1 gold, 1 bronze
- Rename children– my account, school pupils or tag photo



Assessment- Summative

- Core Tasks
- End of unit on last lesson
- Use outcomes from each lesson to inform end of unit judgement
- End of year – curriculum standardized scores
