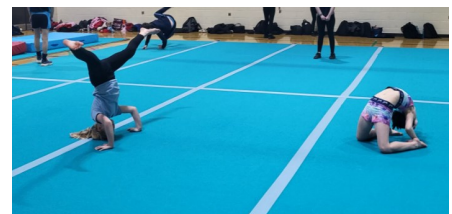

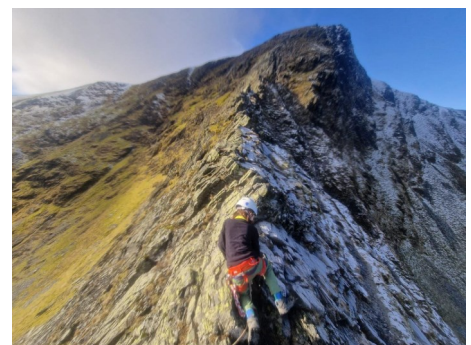
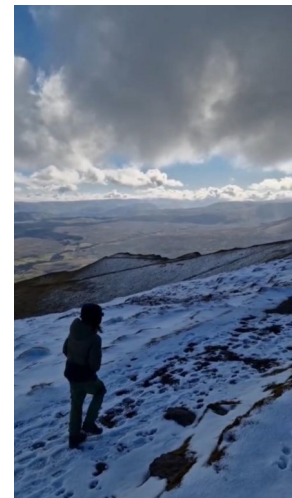
**Matilda** - "Matilda has been working hard at her acro classes since last summer and has built up her skills as well as confidence whilst meeting some new friends.."
