MINUTES COUNT! Attend Today = Achieve Tomorrow


As a school we are very fortunate to have parents that completely understand and support the importance of attendance.

We often see patterns from our attendance data showing the same children arriving late. Every minute counts so can we make a big effort to get our children to school before 9am, ready to start the lessons. Anyone arriving after the 9am register is marked late. Fines FOR BEING LATE CAN ALSO OCCUR.

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Our Trust Virtues


