



### Morning Drop Offs

Parents just a polite reminder that children should not be arriving to school before 8.45am to go and sit in the classroom. Breakfast club is from 8am -8.45am for all children so please make use of the club if you need to drop your child off any earlier than 8.45am. Teachers are not always in their classrooms and it is a safeguarding concern if we have children in school earlier than expected. We have seen a growing number of children arriving between 8.35am -8.40am. Breakfast club can be booked on Scopay, and any children arriving earlier than 8.45am will be asked to go along to breakfast club and unfortunately parents will have to be charged.

Breakfast club is £2.50—includes a variety of breakfast choices ( hot and cold) and morning play activities. Breakfast Club is free to PP children.
