Holy Week events

This week we have had our Wow week for Holy Week. It started last Friday when we had a visit from CAFOD to talk about Catholic Social Teachings - why we help others and behave in a certain way. Our children very quickly realised that the workshops were linked with our school values and now understand why we need to show these values to each other.





On Tuesday Owl class lead a beautiful Easter reflection, through drama, music and readings. This year we chose to have this in church so it would be more special. They certainly showed us the true meaning of Easter.







On Wednesday we had a very busy day using our wonderful outdoor space. In the morning the children walked through the wide wood to view The Stations of the Cross. Each class had shared a piece of art work, drama or symbol (hot cross buns, crown of thorns, cross) linked to one of the stations and reflected quickly, listening to the sounds of outside. In the afternoon the whole school took part in our Big Lenten Walk, which raised £264.76 for CAFOD. Even though it was extremely muddy the children enjoyed walking around our field together and talking with their friends.









This weekend it is the Easter Tridium, when we will prepare for the celebration of Jesus rising from the dead. During this time, we are filled with hope and joy and we look for new life.

The disciples realised that Jesus is risen from the dead and they believe in him. Jesus died; yet Jesus lives. This fills us with great hope. 
