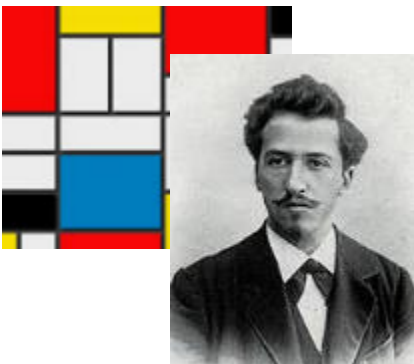

## Say Cheese!

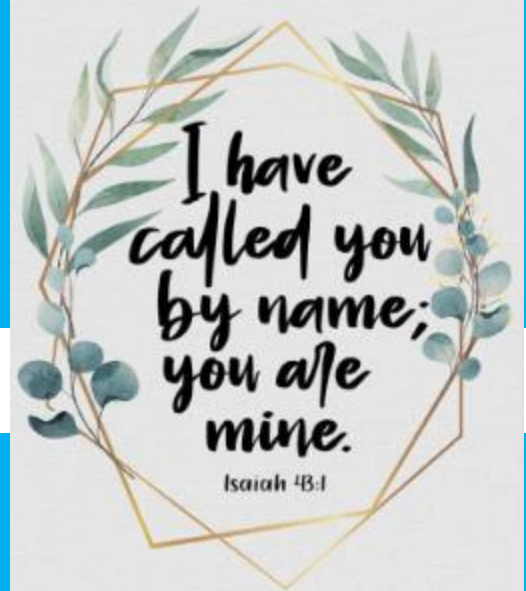

There is only one of you.

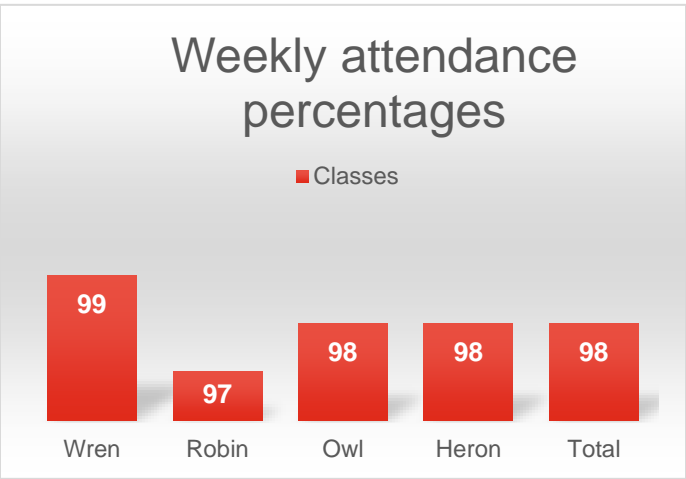
