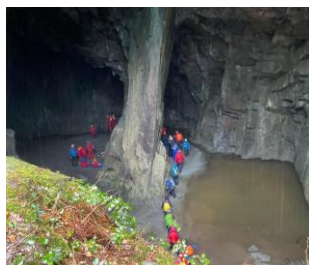

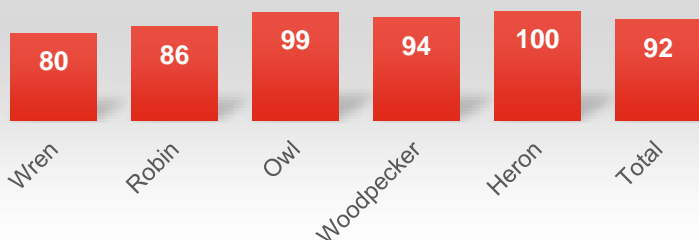
Water Park
