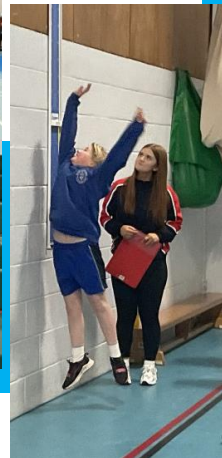
Sporting Events

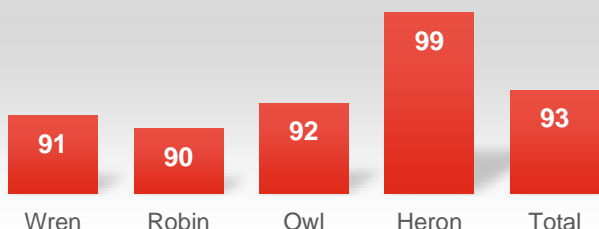
