Value-Forgiveness

This week we have launched our new half termly value of 'Forgiveness'. This value is extremely important as it shows we can truly live like Jesus.

In our assembly the children learnt about the unforgiving servant- a parable told by Jesus to explain why we should forgive. Jesus actually mentioned that we should forgive each other 77 times. For Jesus to say "77," then, would be to exaggerate this standard of perfection – a metaphorical way of saying "forgive until you reach perfect perfection." In essence, Jesus was saying "forgive to infinity."

It does not mean that we let others get away with things, but more that we make a conscious effort to forgive and let go of feelings that come with bearing a grudge against a person.

These feelings of anger and hatred can cause harm to the person feeling them, so Jesus taught people to try and let them go.

There is no act more difficult than to forgive someone, especially when they may have caused harm or upset. To show forgiveness is an act of love.
