We're excited to see our pupils rise to the challenge and continue to make our school a respectful, positive place to learn and grow.

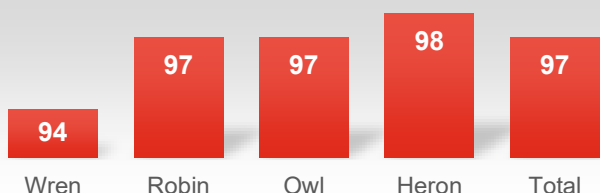
