Due to the continued rise in food production and staffing costs, we will be increasing the price of school lunches after the October half term. This decision has not been taken lightly, and we understand it represents a noticeable change. However, it is important to note that we have not adjusted our lunch prices for over five years.

Starting after the break, the cost of a school meal will be £2.90. This reflects the need to ensure the sustainability of our catering service, as recent reviews have shown we are currently operating at a loss.
