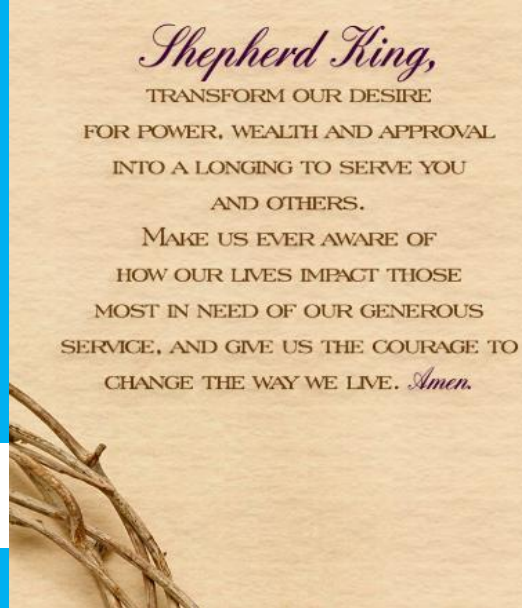


Arbor updates
