Stuart Robinson – England Rugby wheelchair olympian joined us for the day and co-ordinated circuits for the children,

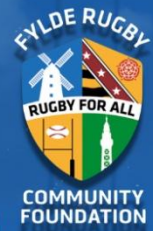


followed by a Q&A session where he was open and honest about his disability.
