### Knowledge

By the end of this unit of study, pupils will be able to:

One	Print with a range of hard and soft materials e.g. sponges, fruit, vegetables,	
Two	Experiment making simple prints.	
Three	Experiment with shape and pattern, looking at repeated patterns and different materials to make textures.	
Four	Demonstrate a range of techniques, e.g. rolling, pressing, stamping and rubbing.
