Writing Non-Negotiables For Years 2

Year 2 Expected Standard

- Write simple, coherent narratives about personal experiences and those of others.
- Write about real events, recording these simply and clearly.
- Use capital letters, full stops and guestion marks consistently.
- Use present and past tense mostly correctly and consistently.
- Use co-ordination (e.g. or / and / but) and some subordination (e.g. when / if / that / because) to join clauses.
- Segment spoken words into phonemes and represent these by graphemes, spelling many of these words correctly and making phonically-plausible attempts at others.
- Spell many common exception words.
- Form upper and lower case letters correctly.
- Use spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters.

Year 2 – Greater Depth

- Can write effectively for different purposes drawing on their own knowledge/reading etc.
- Can proof-read and make simple corrections to their writing.
- Can use all punctuation at KS1 mostly correctly.
- Can spell most common exception words.
- Can add suffixes to spell most words correctly (-ment, -ness, -ful, -less, -ly etc)
- Can use diagonal and horizontal strokes to join certain letters.
