# Westgate Road School Street- a request from St Mary's Governors

Before the end of the summer term, the council approved the continuation of the school street on Westgate Road. We are sure you'll all agree that the school street has been a hugely positive thing, making school drop offs and pick ups much safer, healthier and more pleasant for everyone. We are delighted that the council approved its continuation.

However, much like the crossing patrol, the Council will not provide any funding to run it. This means the barriers at the two ends of Westgate Road will have to continue to be manned by volunteers at least in the short term, thus our appeal to you.

We need as many parents as possible to volunteer to do shift on the barrier. The shifts are 30 minutes long and run from 8.25am to 8.55am and 3.05pm to 3.35pm. If enough parents volunteer then each parent would only have to do one shift per term. A perk of volunteering is that you are able to park on Westgate Road for the duration of your shift.

#### Dinner money

Meals for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are funded via the government's Universal Infant Free School Meals grant and are at no charge to parents.

Payment for school meals for children in Years 3 to 6 should be made via ParentPay. Meals are £2.40 per day.

Please ensure that your child's account stays in credit. If you need help with your ParentPay account, please contact Mrs Bernadette Smith.

# **Snacks**

Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils are provided with free fruit at morning break. KS2 children may bring fresh fruit <u>only</u> to eat at playtimes. We have 'Healthy School' status and children do not bring sweets or fizzy drinks to school.

We have a number of children with severe nut allergies so food containing nuts cannot come in for snack or lunch.



#### Mobile phones in school

If your child walks to or from school unaccompanied by an adult, they may bring a mobile phone to school. All phones must be switched off and handed in at the office first thing in the morning and they can be collected at the end of the day. They should remain switched off until the child leaves school grounds.

Teachers cannot keep pupils' phones in classrooms. If your child attends a club, the phone should be given to the club provider for safekeeping.
