The Order lived a life devoted to the Eucharist and the Christian education of children and this mission continues today. They have convents and schools across the world including India, the Philippines, USA and across Europe.

Little Wandle phonics update

The children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 have started using the Little Wandle (LW) phonics program in their classroom phonics practice. Next week, will start to introduce the LW phonics reading books in classroom reading practice and are aiming to start using the ebooks from week commencing Monday 23rd. Until then, children will continue to bring home a phonicallyappropriate reading scheme book or a sharing book to read together at home. The sharing book will be chosen by your child and will include words they cannot yet read - the aim of this book is to provide a book that they will enjoy reading with you at home.
