### COVID-19 update

We have had six further cases of Covid-19 amongst the children and staff this week. Please continue to be vigilant.

What should I do if my child has COVID-19 symptoms?

If your child has any of the main COVID-19

symptoms (a high temperature, a new continuous cough, or a loss or change to sense of smell or taste), they should not attend school and should stay at home. You should arrange for them to get a <u>PCR test</u> and send the school a copy of the test results. Your child should not attend school while you are waiting for test results, even if they are feeling better. If the test is negative, they should go to school as normal. If they test positive, they should continue to isolate and follow public health advice.

Schools no longer trace close contacts - close contacts will be identified via NHS Test and Trace.

## **Birthday books**

Because we have a number of children with allergies, we cannot permit sweets and cakes for birthdays, even if they are to be distributed on the playground after school.
