#### First Holy Communion celebration

Many of our children have made or will make their First Holy Communion this term. Our school celebration for these children will take place on 24<sup>th</sup> June. These are the arrangements.

- There is a whole school Mass at 9.10am to which parents are invited.
- Year 3 children come to school and change into their First Holy Communion clothes before whole school Mass; children in Year 3 who haven't made their First Holy Communion may wear party/ home clothes instead and they are included in the celebration.
- The six children in Year 4 who made or will make their First Holy Communion this year may bring their communion clothes and join with Year 3.
- After Mass, one class will go into the small hall for their refreshments while the other class goes outside for photos, and then they swap.
- Afterwards, children change back into their uniform for normal lessons.
- All parents are invited to the Mass.
