
### **Literacy**

*During our literacy lessons we will continue to reinforce sentence structure and punctuation as well as having the opportunity for extended writing in different genres. Through different high quality the children will have the opportunity to develop their writing skills.*

*Guided reading sessions will continue to develop comprehension skills.*

*This half term we will be concentrating on:*

**Narrative** – Through various texts we will be looking at characters, emotions and feelings in different parts of the stories. We will continue to use videos and diverse literature to engage all children.



## **Mathematics**

*During our maths lessons we will continue to recap elements from the Year 1 summer curriculum and build on this as we reinforce children's understanding of the number system and the skills of written and mental calculations. We are specifically encouraging the children to use and apply their skills in problem solving and puzzles using all operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.*

### **Number Sense and Multiplicative Reasoning:**

- *The children will be working with 2 and 3 digit numbers and develop understanding of place value.*
- *They will learn multiplicative and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.*

### **Statistics:**

- They will make tally charts.
- The children will draw and interpret pictograms.
- The children will interpret block diagrams.

## **Religious Education**

*We will be following 'The Way, the Truth and the Life' scheme and our next topic is 'The Good News.' We will learn that Jesus can change sadness into joy. We will learn about times that Jesus used his power to help others. We will learn that we should always remember to thank Jesus for helping others and for helping us.*

### **RSE**

*We will hear the Story of the Prodigal Son. We will talk about how we treat others and how to say sorry. We will also learn about staying safe and good secrets and bad secrets.*



## **Behaviour in Year 2**

*In Year 2 positive praise and reinforcement is used by both class teachers. The children are rewarded for good behavior and hard work through stickers and their class bear. Each Year 2 class has a class bear which gets to go home with a child for the weekend. We also encourage the children to show good pieces of work to the adjacent class teacher. On the rare occasion that a child does not make the right choice they will be given a verbal warning from their class teacher. If this type of behavior persists then they will be sent next door to the adjacent class teacher for a short period of time to complete their work.*

## **Other Curriculum Areas**

**P.E.:** the children will learn a Mexican Dance and will also have a weekly session with our PE coach.

**Geography:** we will locate Mexico on a world map and consider modes of transport for getting there. We will be comparing our locality with Tocuaro, a village in Mexico. We will study the Horta family and compare their family life with ours.

**Design and technology:** our new topic is 'Guacamole'. We will be looking at a Mexican Party and we will plan, make and evaluate guacamole.

**Computing:** the children will follow a unit of programming in scratch.

**Music:** the children will continue to sing and enjoy music lessons with Miss Ambrose.



## **Homework and How You Can Help At Home**

*Literacy homework will be given on Friday to be returned by Wednesday. Children should read a wide range of genres and texts at home and it is important that the text is discussed as this develops comprehension skills. Drawing attention to sentence structure and text structure will support your child's own writing.*

*In mathematics regular revision of basic number concepts such as number bonds, tables and place value are important. The use of maths in our everyday lives is also important such as telling the time, weighing in the kitchen and handling money. Homework will be given out on Friday to be returned on Wednesday.*
