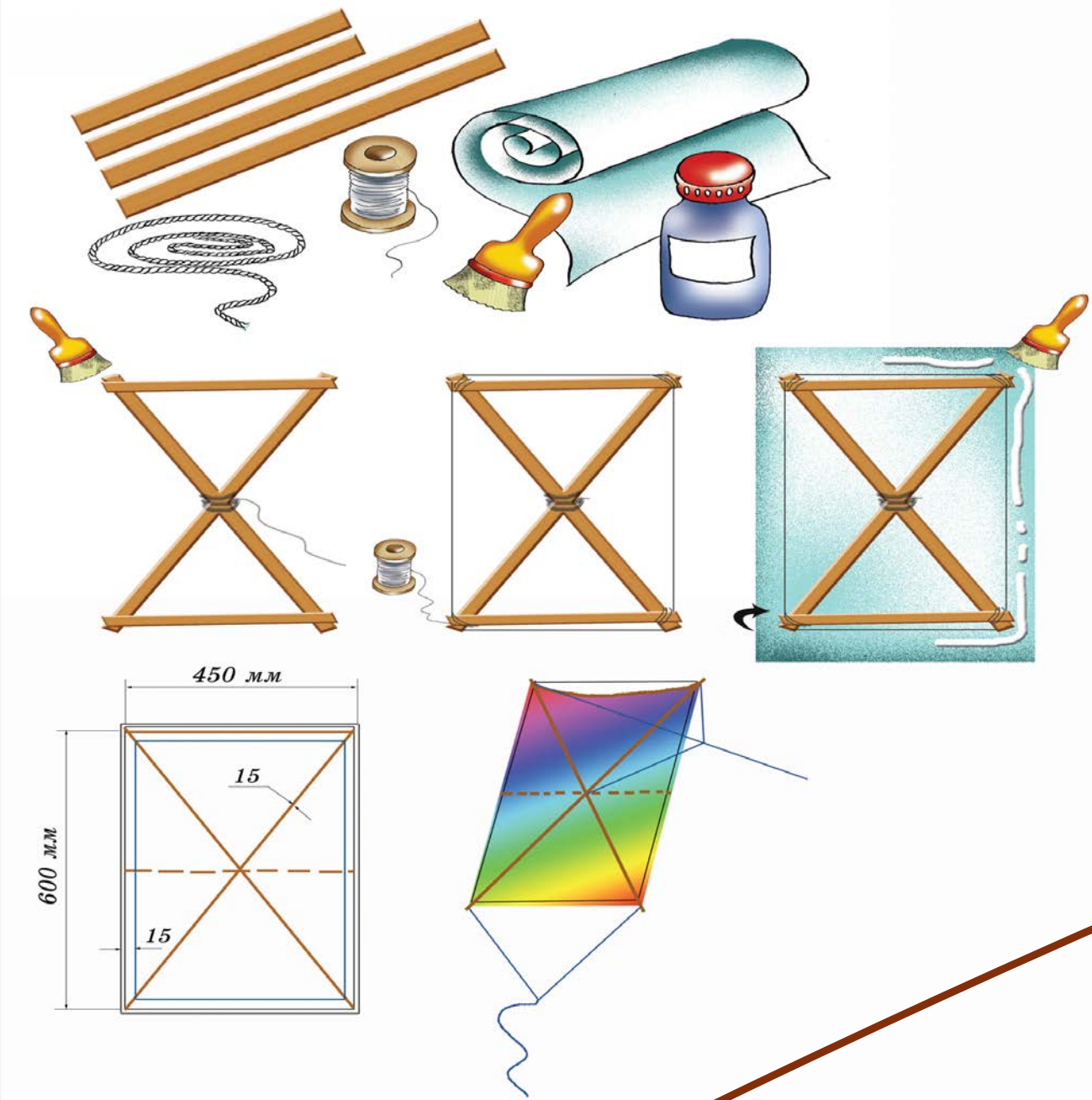

worked.



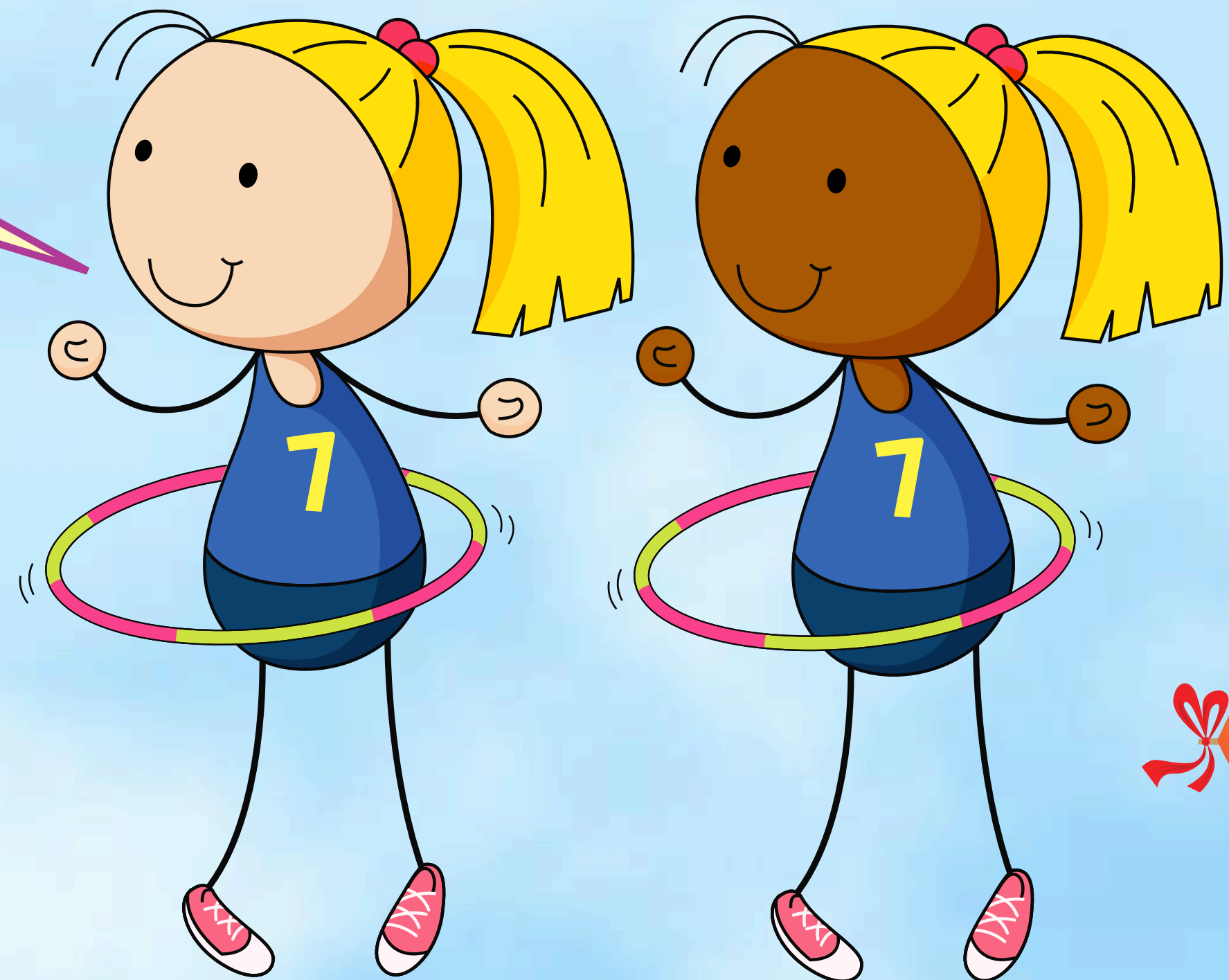
Most designers

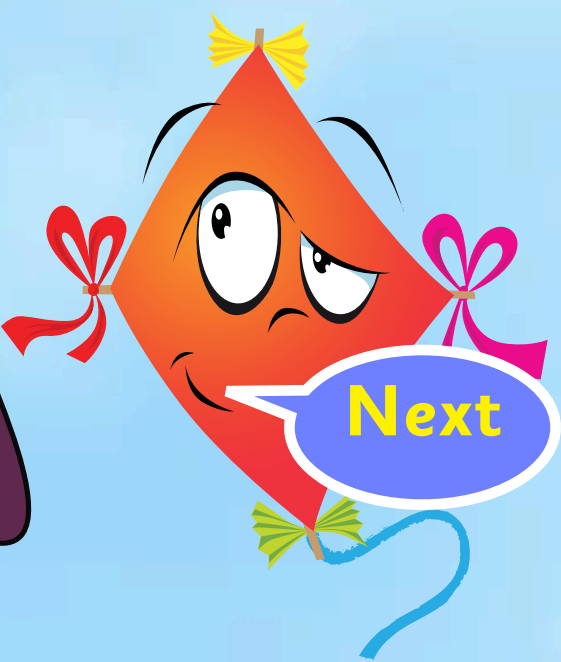

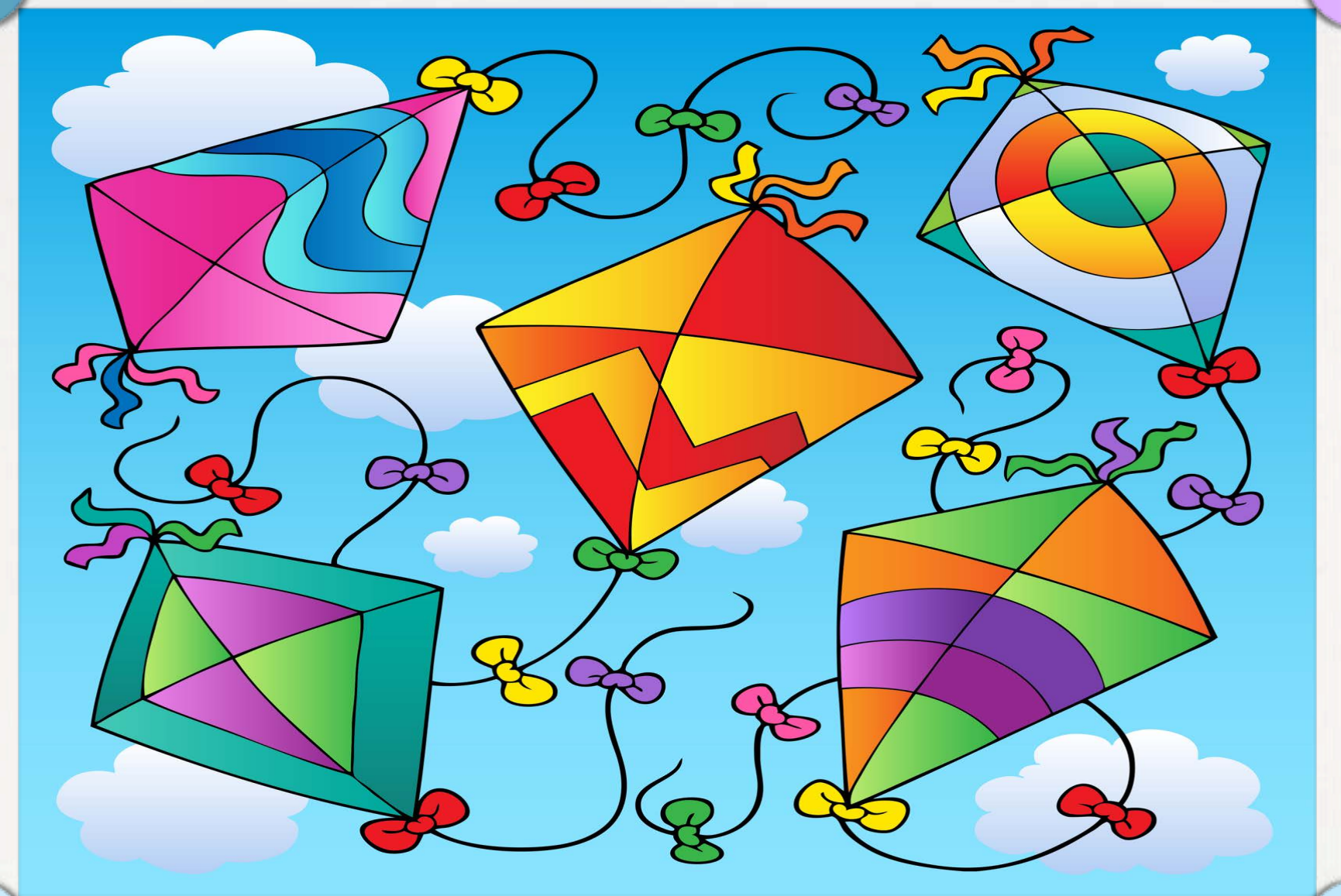
