Follow these steps to make a Carp Kite.

Step 1

Cut out scale shapes and glue them in a line. Overlap more lines over the top until you are three-quarters of the way up the paper.



Step 2

Cut a black strip of paper and two round circles. Glue the strip over the last layer of scales. Glue the eyes on. Roll the fish and attach the sides together with tape.



Step 3

Ask your teacher for a hole puncher and make holes on both sides of the fish's head. Thread string through the holes and tie a knot.

Follow these steps to make a Carp Kite.

Step 1

Cut out scale shapes and glue them in a line. Overlap more lines over the top until you are three-quarters of the way up the paper.



Step 2

Cut a black strip of paper and two round circles. Glue the strip over the last layer of scales. Glue the eyes on. Roll the fish and attach the sides together with tape.



Step 3

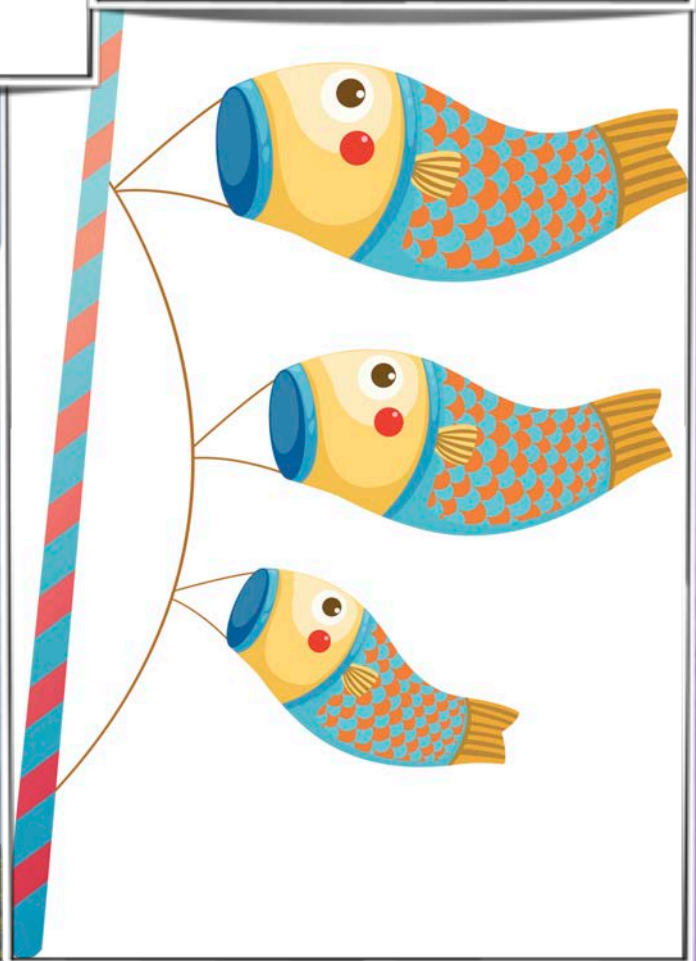
Ask your teacher for a hole puncher and make holes on both sides of the fish's head. Thread string through the holes and tie a knot.



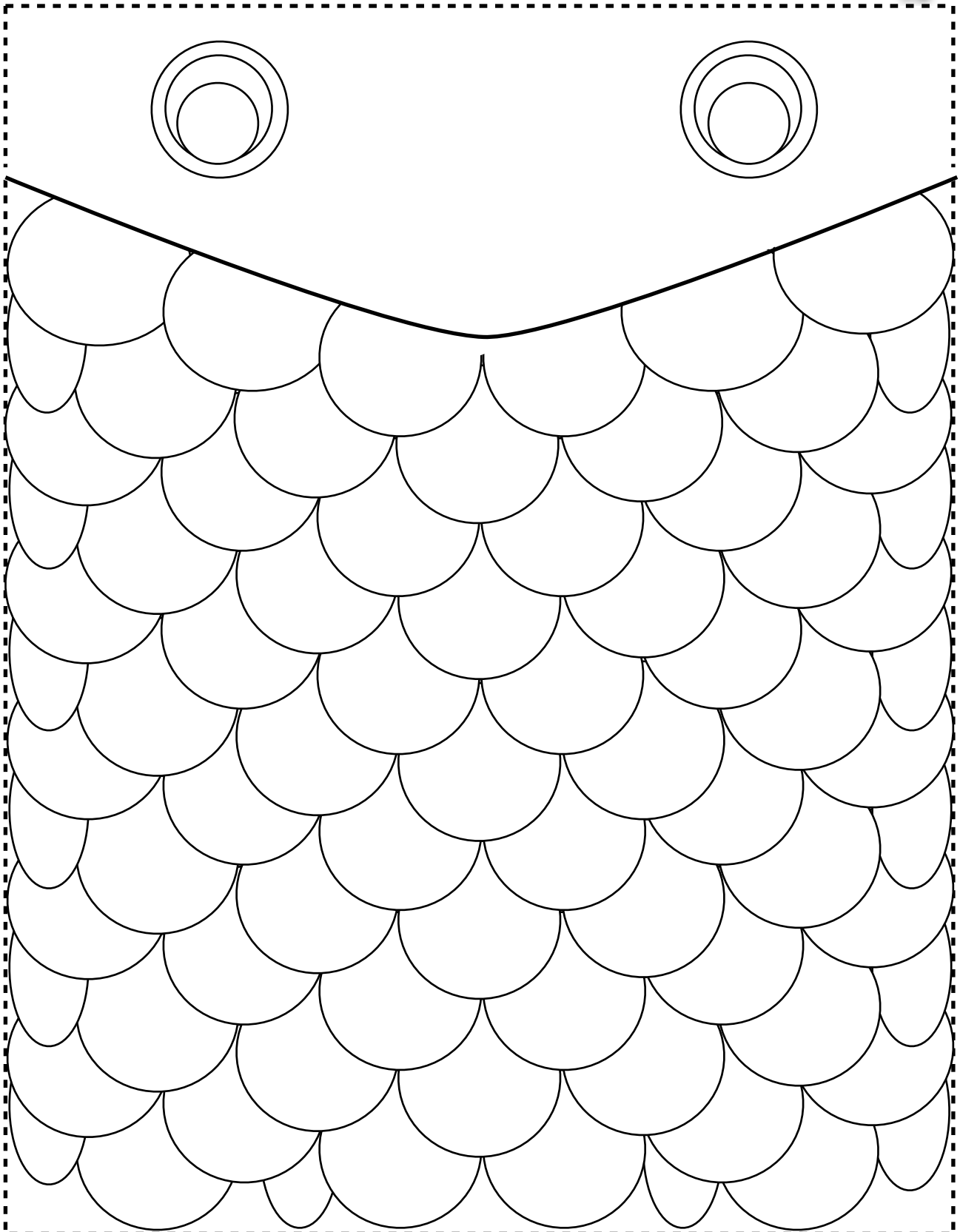

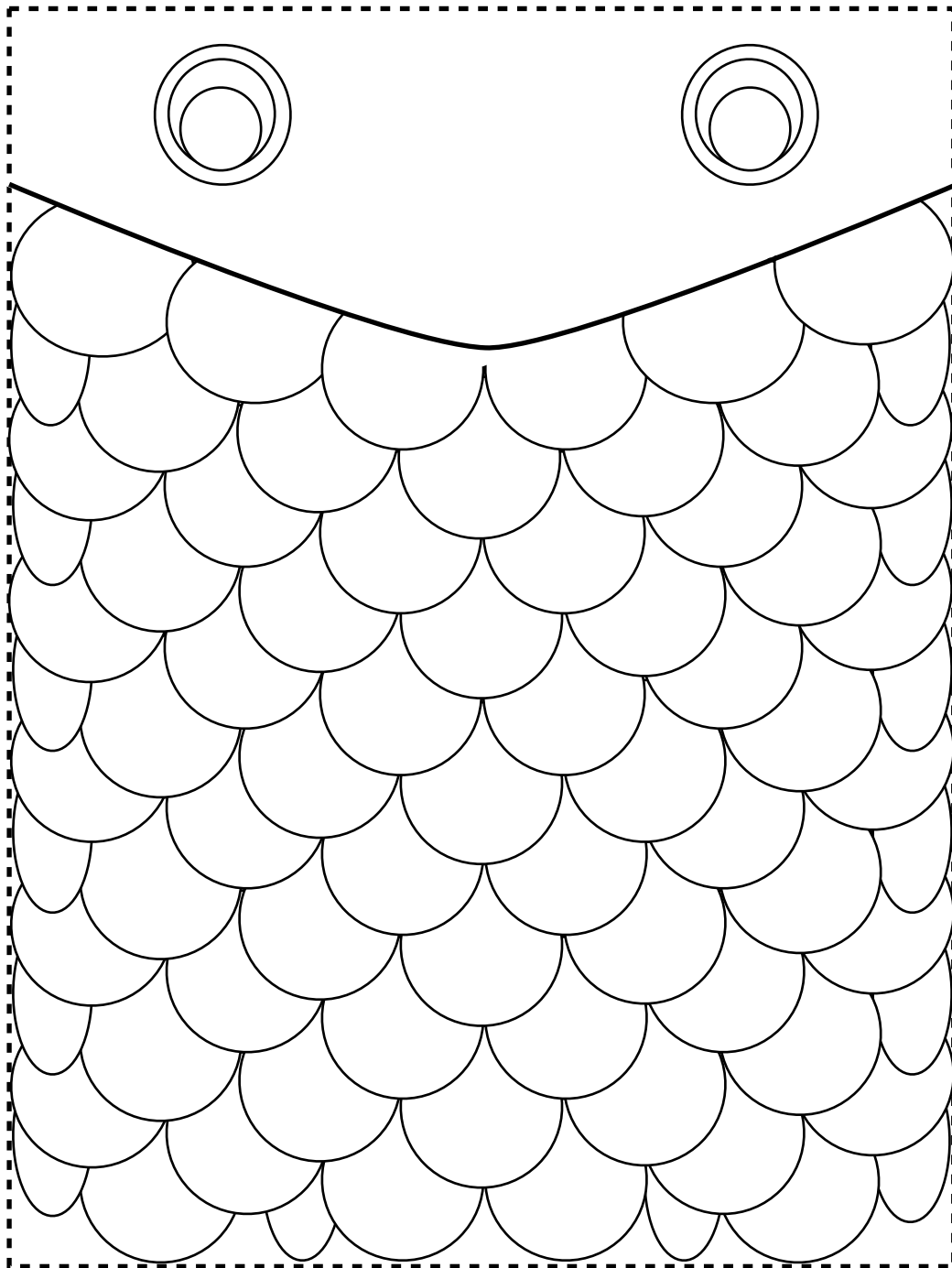
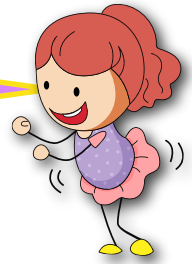
Carp Kites are sometimes flown together on large poles or sticks. The larger kite is attached at the top and the smaller one is at the bottom. Let's make one of our own.
