## **Dear Parents**

As we approach the end of yet another academic year (and one which I'm sure we are all more than ready for a break from!) the PTA would like to tell you about what we have achieved over the last year and the role we play at St Mary's.

Despite being unable to meet face to face for some time now, we have continued to stay connected through regular coffee mornings and wine evenings – our PTA is not only about fundraising for our school but also about establishing strong friendships and providing support to one another, something that has proven invaluable during the pandemic.

Despite the difficulties all PTAs have faced over the last year, we have continued with our fundraising, albeit slightly differently to usual! Since last September, we have raised an amazing total of over £11,600 through our 2020 commemorative mugs, Cash 4 Clothes collection, non-uniform day, pre-loved uniform sale and 59 Club, not to mention the incredible PTA 10k event last November. Not only have our phenomenal fundraising efforts helped to provide some brilliant things for our school including resources for all classes, resources for Forest School and ELSA provision, new rabbit hutch, basketball hoops, tumble drier, fridge for the Early Years classroom, new PE shed and the weekly dance and drama lessons delivered by Georgia Holloway but we have also been able to complete our outdoor project, The Horti Hub. Phew! The Horti Hub has now become an integral part of St Mary's and one which benefits the children enormously – they are learning about where their food comes from, sustainability, how to plant, nurture and harvest their food as well as benefitting from being outdoors in a calm and beautiful space.
