Dear Parents

Can you believe we are almost at the end of another academic year? It seems to have flown by in a flash, although St Mary's PTA have been working tirelessly throughout, raising lots of money to support our lovely school.

Over the last year, through events such as our Horti Hub Grand Opening, Carwash, Big Breakfast, (our 'Back Together Again Big Breakfast' made us a National PTA Awards Community Initiative of the Year finalist!), Christmas Wreath Making Workshop, Colton Christmas Fair, Christmas Disco, Easter Bingo, Valentine's Disco, Sports Day BBQ and Pre-Loved Uniform Sale, not to mention sales of our fabulous Jubilee Tea Towels, we have raised almost £3,500! Wow!

These phenomenal fundraising efforts have been ploughed straight back into school and have provided some amazing things such as the installation of a bike shelter in the school car park (we won this by applying for a grant), repairs to the school field, the purchase of four balance bikes and safety helmets for our Early Years provision, £400 towards new reading books and a new PC monitor for use in the school library as an extra teaching space. The money has also been used to buy reading boxes and blankets for each class so the children are able to read outside, two new football goals for the school field, subscribe to various reading and magazine resources, fund our weekly dance and drama provision by Georgia Holloway, buy a new run for the school guinea-pig, buy some decorative items for the children's jubilee garden, as well as purchase our Year 6 Leaver's Hoodies and pay for their Leaver's celebration event. Phew!

We continue to update our memorial planter for Joan Kinsman with seasonal plants in front of St Mary's church, too; do take a wander, if you get the chance, and have a look at the beautiful blooming geraniums planted in her memory.

I hope you will agree that our PTA have achieved an incredible amount this year and we look forward to continuing to do so again throughout the following year.

We are thrilled to have some of our fabulous fundraising events already in the diary for the autumn term – we have an informal welcome coffee morning on 23rd September 8.30 - 10am for all parents and would love to see as many of you there as possible! Not only will it be great to catch up with everyone after the summer break, but it will also be a wonderful opportunity to say hello to new families and also for them to get to know others who have joined the school.
