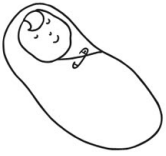

Date of birth: September 7, 1533

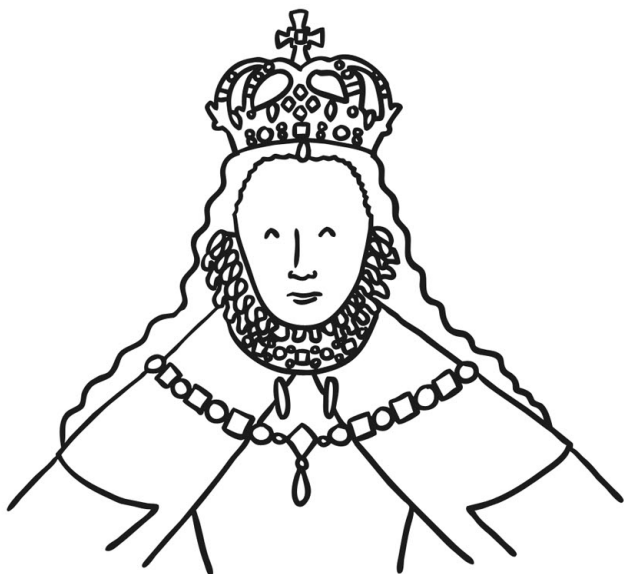


Date of death: March 24, 1603
