## Paper Plate Easter Basket

### Supplies

- 2 paper plates
- Brown paint
- White card
- Scraps of wrapping paper
- PVA glue
- Scissors



- Ruler
- Pencil
- Paint brushes





Turn the paper plates upside down. Use a ruler to draw a line across the middle of each plate, ensure that the line stops where the rim of the plate begins at each side.



Stick the second set of eggs on to the opposite side of the card, then leave to dry.



Using scissors, cut along the line and around the curved edge of the plate. This should leave the rim of the paper plate intact, with a semi-circle cut out.



Using PVA glue, stick some of the egg shapes onto the inside of one paper plate so that the eggs overlap the semi-circle hole.



Paint both undersides of the plates with brown paint, then leave to dry.



Repeat step 7 with the other paper plate and the rest of the eggs. Then leave to dry.



Draw and cut out egg shapes from several different pieces of wrapping paper. You will need two per colour.



Once dry, run a line of glue around the edge of one paper plate on the non-painted side. Then gently stick the other plate onto it, ensuring the semicircle holes and the handle line up correctly.



Stick one set of eggs onto the white card. Then cut out the egg shapes.

# Paper Plate Easter Basket



#### **Supplies**

- 2 paper plates
- Brown paint
- White card
- Scraps of wrapping paper
- PVA glue
- Scissors



– Pencil

- Paint brushes





Step 1. Turn the paper plates upside down.

Use a ruler to draw a line across the middle of each plate, ensure that the line stops where the rim of the plate begins at each side.



**Step 2.** Using scissors, cut along the line and around the curved edge of the plate. This should leave the rim of the paper plate intact, with a semi-circle cut out.



**Step 3.** Paint both undersides of the plates with brown paint, then leave to dry.



**Step 4.** Draw and cut out egg shapes from several different pieces of wrapping paper. You will need two per colour.



**Step 5.** Stick one set of eggs onto the white card. Then cut out the egg shapes.



**Step 6.** Stick the second set of eggs on to the opposite side of the card, then leave to dry.



**Step 7.** Using PVA glue, stick some of the egg shapes onto the inside of one paper plate so that the eggs overlap the semi-circle hole.



**Step 8.** Repeat step 7 with the other paper plate and the rest of the eggs. Then leave to dry.



**Step 9.** Once dry, run a line of glue around the edge of one paper plate on the non-painted side. Then gently stick the other plate onto it, ensuring the semi-circle holes and the handle line up correctly.
