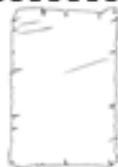
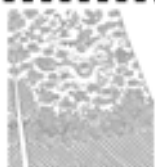


The Silk Road

- What items did the different places offer for trade?









Trading Items
