
Spellings

Many of our words, or parts of words, in the English language have come from other languages, both ancient and modern.

Sometimes by knowing the origin of the word it can help us to remember and understand the spelling of the word. This is called etymology.



This is a word web to show how words are interrelated and linked by learning. This is based on the word sign taken from the French *signe* and the Latin *signum*, meaning 'sign'.

You are to take the root word *press* (from Latin and Old French) to build a word web like the model above
