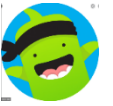

Can you say the rhyming words aloud and then ask an adult to help you write them in your red book?	Use your painting or drawing of the teddy bear from yesterday and write a sentence to describe him. E.g. The teddy is big or The teddy is brown and small. Think about using a capital letter and full stop.	Choose your favourite teddy bear from home. Have a teddy bears picnic with your teddy using cups and plates and make a name card for you and your teddy to use at the picnic. Use Sheet 4.	Make a list of picnic food that you would like to have at a teddy bears picnic. Think about your phonics sounds and write your list on Sheet 8. Upload a picture to do jo.
