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Attendance

Mrs Naik regularly monitors attendance levels over the school year and has noted individuals who have higher than acceptable levels of absence from school. Government expectation is a minimum of 96% attendance over a school year from every child, unless there are exceptional reasons for absence (holidays in term time are **not** classed as exceptional reasons).

If your child is one of the ones with this excessively high level of absence, you will be receiving a letter from me making this clear to you and that we will be monitoring their attendance levels even more closely this year and will be in contact through phone calls and home visits should any absence occur.

School Reading Books

I am delighted to let you know that we have been able to invest £10,000 in improving our reading books at school. You will notice that your child is bringing home a nice new book to read and we hope that you will enjoy being able to read along with them every night as this is the best way to help them improve rapidly. Please do note that if a book is lost or damaged we will be in touch to seek a contribution of at least £5 towards replacement as books are very expensive to replace.

School Gates

Thank you for your patience over the first couple of days, we have been looking carefully at it and are going to trial the following changes at the end of the day from Tuesday onwards.

Gates from the small yard – Year 3 to continue leaving from here and Year 6 to join them Gate in the corner for the big yard – Year 4 to leave from this gate. Gate by Nursery entrance – Year 5 to leave from this gate. Infants continue as they are.



Thank you for your patience, please can I **urge** you not to crowd the gates and to take care when moving around Derby Square. Also, car users PLEASE do not bring your cars onto Derby Square at the beginning and end of the school day, it is a very crowded area and we all want to avoid an accident happening.

School Meals

As you will be aware from the news, there are big problems with the supply chain for getting food and other items around our country. This is now beginning to impact on the school meals service who are experiencing difficulties in getting hold of some food items.

Due to these problems, this is the menu for this week:

- Monday Quorn sausage in gravy with mashed potato and carrots OR cheese/tuna Sandwich
- Tuesday Cheese pasty with hash brown OR Pasta OR cheese/tuna/egg sandwich
- Wednesday Jackets with cheese or tuna or baked beans OR cheese/tuna/egg sandwich
- Thursday Quorn burger with hash brown OR cheese/tuna/egg sandwich
- Friday Pizza and chips OR cheese/tuna/egg sandwich

We are aware that this is not the range that we would normally provide but hope you understand and bear with us as the catering service deal with the challenges.
