Even though we are 'getting back to normal' Covid is still around and likely to increase as we go into Autumn and then Winter. I would encourage all families to carry out at least weekly Lateral Flow Tests (kits available here <a href="https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests">https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests</a>) as we are finding that many people, especially children, are not displaying symptoms but are carrying the virus.
