School Applications.

If your child is currently in Year 6, please do not forget that the closing date for applications for Secondary School is the 31st October. All applications need to be made via the following link <https://www.lancashire.gov.uk/children-education-families/schools/apply-for-a-school-place/apply-online-for-a-school-place/> If you are applying to a faith based school, you will also need to complete their Supplementary Information Form.

Please note, I have had several requests for me to sign applications for Preston Muslim Girls' School; I have been in touch with the school and this section (Section 5) is only for those whose child currently attends the Olive School in Fulwood.

Applications for Primary School places are also open and can be made via the same link. If you have a child starting Reception in September 2022 or you know someone who has, please make your application – the deadline is 15th January 2022

Be on time!

Hopefully you will have seen our new banners on Derby Square which highlight the impact of not coming to school and how much learning children miss.

It is also very important the children come to school on time – no child likes to have to walk in late to the hall for worship or into class when the rest have already started working.

You also need to know that arriving late at school may also be recorded as an unauthorised absence which could lead to a fine – these are not our rules but the law which we have to follow.

If this happens three times, then the Walking Bus will no longer be able to come to collect you.
