


NEWSLETTER 6 –18th October 2023

Absence

If your child is absent for any reason, you **must** ring the school office before 9am to inform them. If you do not, you may well get a visit from our attendance team and the absence may be recorded as unauthorised. Office hours are 8am to 3:45pm

Jewellery & PE

We are aware that there are some children who still have earrings in when they come to school for PE and parents report difficulties in removing them. A reminder that PE is a compulsory part of the National Curriculum and that the wearing of earrings or other jewellery is not allowed.

If you are having difficulty removing them, we advise you to visit where your child had their ears pierced or another piercing specialist to get assistance in removing them.
